Minutes from last meeting were read and agreed.

#### Treasurer's update

£1,000 was sent to Cancer Research and receipt of this has been received, leaving £164.10 in the account.

### Secretary's update

Julie apologised for not chasing Morrisons regarding the collection, this will be followed up asap! World Cancer Day is 4<sup>th</sup> February 2018, this was discussed further in the meeting.

#### Chairperson's update

Maggie read an email from Claire Woolsey withdrawing from the committee. Maggie will forward Cancer Research updates to committee members as this provides information on how the charity money is spend and the percentage of funds towards various projects, research receiving the largest percentage but also money spent on areas such as prevention and education. Copy from their update. In 2016/17 spent a total of £666 million using money raised during this financial year plus extra money gained, for example through investments.

We spent £473 million on all of our work to help beat cancer.

This includes:

- £432 million towards <u>research</u>. We spent around two-thirds of this on research into specific types of cancer and a third on research into cancer biology, which underpins all types of cancer. This money was spent across research sites, awards and support costs.
- £41 million spent on our <u>policy and information</u> activities. This includes prevention and early diagnosis work; campaigning; communicating health messages; and engaging patients, the public and health professionals.
- We spent £386 million on life-saving research carried out in 2016/17, including £112 million into the biology of cancer that underpins the rest of our research. We also set aside money for future work on long-term projects that are running over several years. The total amount we put towards research in 2016/17 was £432 million.
- We're working to prevent cancer, diagnose it earlier, develop new treatments and optimise existing treatments to make them more effective. Our 2016/17 spend on research includes £38 million on clinical trials, £37 million on research into new

drugs, and £17 million on research into possible causes of cancer, helping people to reduce their risk.

We have new contact details with a central number for Cancer Research, this should help when our contact Cameron is away.
